Works notice: Monday 23 September 2024 **Grose Street and Hospital Road footpath works**

From Monday 23 September 2024 for approximately three weeks sections of the pedestrian footpath adjacent to the RPA Staff and Visitor Car Park on Grose Street and Hospital Road will be closed. Pedestrian access will be maintained via the dedicated footpath outside the Queen Mary building entrance.

The RPA Staff and Visitor Car Park Level 3B (street level) fire stair doors leading to Grose Street will be closed for the duration of works. Traffic controllers will be on site and there will be temporary detour signage installed to help people navigate the construction impacts.

With part of Grose Street currently closed to vehicles, drivers are reminded that there is limited space on Grose Street to perform a three-point turn and will need to use an alternate route.

The works may produce some noise during saw cutting and we will continue to monitor the activity so we can minimise impacts where possible. The nature of construction activities could be impacted by weather conditions or other utility factors and we will notify you of any changes.

Key impacts

- Small section of pedestrian footpath adjacent to car park closed
- RPA Staff and Visitor Car Park Level 3B (street level) fire stair doors closed
- Limited space on Grose Street for three-point turn
- Possible noise during saw cutting
- Traffic control and signage in place



Temporary helicopter landing site
