

Works notice: Thursday 18 July 2024 Level 4 café balcony closure

From Thursday 18 July to Friday 2 August 2024 the Level 4 main hospital café balcony will be closed while construction hoarding is installed.

The RPA Hospital redevelopment is completing preparatory works for the future construction of a link bridge between RPA Hospital and the Sydney Biomedical Accelerator and the expansion of RPA operating theatres.

From Thursday 18 July to Friday 2 August 2024 the Level 4 main hospital café balcony will be closed while construction hoarding is installed. The hoarding will be in place for an extended period of time to protect the public from ongoing construction activities in this space.

On Monday 22 July 2024 there will be a mobile crane in the closure on Gloucester House Drive to assist with material delivery.

It is expected that from Monday 5 August to Friday 16 August 2024, balcony removal works will be carried out behind the hoarding. The terrace area will be accessible however there will be some noise and vibration from construction activities.

Key impacts

- Level 4 main hospital cafe balcony closed from Thursday 18 July to Friday 2 August 2024
- Mobile crane in use on Gloucester House Drive on Monday 22 July 2024
- Balcony removal works behind the hoarding from Monday 5 August to Friday 16 August 2024
- Hoarding installed and a small section of Level 4 café balcony closed for extended period of time
- Possible noise and vibration
