

## Works notice: Monday 21 October 2024 Piling works for east tower extension

Piling works will continue within the construction sites located outside the future northern arrival on Johns Hopkins Drive and on Lambie Dew Drive.

These works are part of the RPA Hospital east tower extension and involve the installation of steel piles into the ground as a foundation to support the new structure.

The activity is noisy and people nearby may also notice some slight vibration. All noisy works will be completed in intervals, to enable respite periods, and there are noise and vibration monitors installed to monitor impacts.

Piling works will occur between 7am to 6pm weekdays and we will continue to keep you updated as the project progresses.



### Key impacts

- Piling rig installed and in use outside future northern entrance and on Lambie Dew Drive
- Intermittent noise and vibration from piling work
- Traffic controllers on site to help people navigate the space
