

## RPA Hospital Redevelopment Construction update 29 January 2025

Works continue to ready the east campus for the construction of the 15-storey hospital building, with the first tower crane now installed on Lambie Dew Drive. A second tower crane is expected to be installed near Johns Hopkins Drive in mid-2025 and both cranes will be in use for approximately two years.

The RPA Hospital loading dock access remains via Gloucester House Drive only. Johns Hopkins Drive has been temporarily closed to enable new in-ground electrical infrastructure to be built.

Demolition and refurbishment works are underway inside the existing hospital building to reconfigure spaces, and piling works continue near Lambie Dew Drive to support the future hospital expansion.

January has been a busy month for the redevelopment team and we look forward to maintaining this momentum throughout the year.
