

## Works notice: Monday 11 December 2023 Hazardous material removal works on Lambie Dew Drive

From Monday 11 December 2023 works will commence to remove hazardous material identified in the former Chapel and Anatomical Pathology building on Lambie Dew Drive.

A clear separation between public areas and construction zones will be created to eliminate any risk to staff and visitors, and all works concerning hazardous materials will be clearly signposted and involve strict access controls. The works are expected to take three weeks to complete and will be between the hours of 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday.

The RPA project team has developed a hazardous materials management plan in line with Safe Work NSW regulations to maintain a safe environment for staff, contractors and visitors. All remediation works will be completed by qualified professionals, who are experts in hazardous materials management planning, identification, remediation and disposal.

### Safety measures in place for the duration of works:

- Qualified hazardous materials removal workers suited in Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) will carry out the planned works
- Air monitoring will take place and water trucks will be used to suppress any dust throughout the works as a precautionary measure
- Trucks removing the material will be loaded within the site and covered to ensure the safe transport of contaminated materials
- Once works are complete an independent assessor will review the site to provide clearance certificates
