Works notice: Tuesday 17 September 2024 **Brodie Street road closure and detour in place**

From Tuesday 17 September for approximately one week there will be construction works occurring on Hospital Road and access to Brodie Street via Hospital Road will be closed.

From 9.30am to 3pm access to Brodie Street from the intersection of Hospital Road will be closed and entry to the RPA Multi-storey Staff Car Park will be via Missenden Road, down Dunblane Street, left on to Church Street and left on to Brodie Street.

There will be some car spaces on Hospital Road closed during these works and traffic controllers will be in place to help drivers navigate the space. Works will occur outside peak hours to minimise impact.

The nature of the construction activities could be impacted by weather conditions or other utility factors and we will notify you of any changes.

Key impacts

- No access to Brodie Street via Hospital Road from 9.30am to 3pm
- RPA Multi-storey Staff Car Park entry changes
- Construction work on Hospital Road and some car spaces closed during the works
- Traffic controllers in place to help people navigate the space
