

Works notice: Monday 9 September 2024 Brodie Street road closure and detour in place

Between 9.30am and 5pm from Monday 9 September to Wednesday 11 September 2024 (inclusive), there will be a complete road closure on Brodie Street from the intersection of Hospital Road through to the intersection of Church Street.

Entry to the RPA Multi-storey Staff Car Park will be via Missenden Road, down Dunblane Street, left on to Church Street and left on to Brodie Street. Traffic controllers will be in place to help drivers navigate the space and provide access to the Multi-storey Car Park. Works will occur outside peak hours to minimise impact.

The nature of the construction activities could be impacted by weather conditions or other utility factors and we will notify you of any changes.

- Complete road closure on Brodie Street
- Entry to RPA Multi-storey Staff Car Park impacted
- Traffic controllers in place to help people navigate the space and give access to the car park
