Works notice: Monday 2 September 2024 Church Street road closure and detour in place

From 7am, Monday 2 September for approximately two weeks there will be a complete road closure on Church Street from Carillon Avenue intersection through to Grose Street. These works are the final construction activities planned as part of the current Church Street package of works.

Vehicle access to Church Street and Grose Street will be via Hospital Road and Lucas Street or Mallett Street and Fowler Street. Pedestrian access will be maintained but adjusted at times. Due to insufficient space for a turning circle there will be no street parking available in the closed area. Traffic controllers will be on site to help you navigate the space and will provide residents access to driveways when required.

Work hours will be from 7am to 5pm weekdays and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays. There may be some noise and dust from construction activities during this time. All noisy works will be completed in intervals of work and respite, and there will be noise and dust monitors installed to help minimise impacts where possible. Works may be extended due to wet weather and we will notify you of any changes.

Temporary helicopter landing site

These works are part of the construction of the temporary helicopter landing site, which is expected to be completed in late 2024.
