

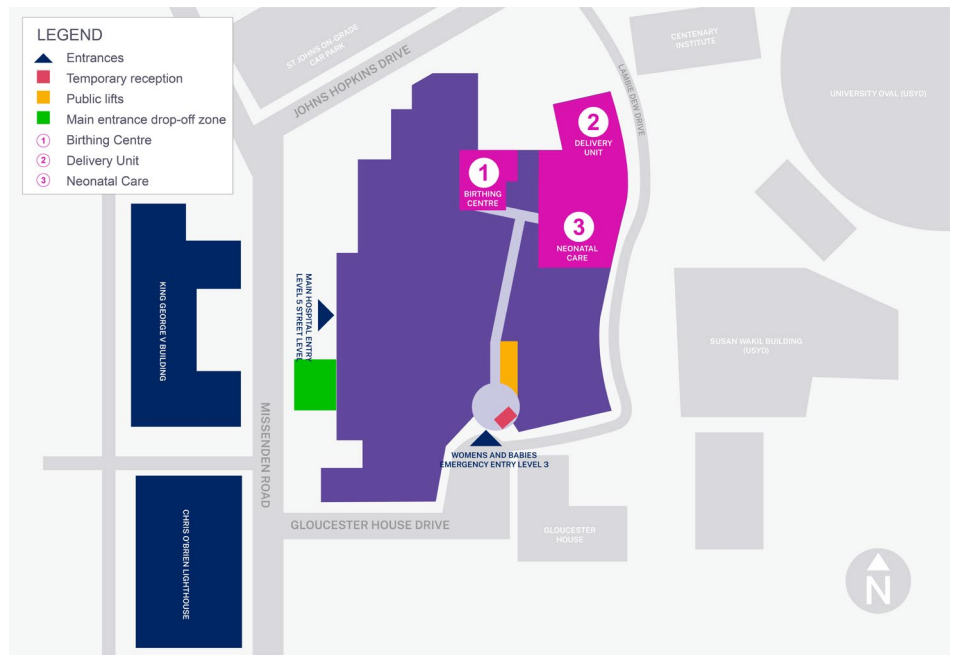
Current construction on campus

Women and Babies entrance changes (new Northern Arrival)

Works have commenced on the future northern entrance at RPA Hospital. This will require the temporary closure of the Women and Babies entrance located on Johns Hopkins Drive.

From Tuesday 23 April 2024, please use the RPA main entrance on Missenden Road to access Delivery Unit, Birth Centre and Neonatal services.

There will be a small drop-off area on Gloucester House Drive that can be used for urgent Maternity access. The Maternity reception desk will be relocated to the southern atrium on level 3. Signs will be in place to help guide people to the appropriate location.



Lambie Dew Drive future building footprint

Construction activity is ramping up on Lambie Dew Drive to prepare the site for the start of main works construction on the future 15-storey clinical services building.

There is no pedestrian access on Lambie Dew Drive and there is no through road from Lambie Dew Drive to Johns Hopkins Drive. Access to the loading dock is currently via Gloucester House Drive.



Temporary helicopter landing site

Works continue on the temporary helicopter landing site located on the roof of the Staff and Visitor Car Park off Hospital Road and Grose Street.

There will be a range of impacts across all levels of the car park, including the temporary loss of car spaces and there is no through road access on Grose Street to Hospital Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, with new lighting installed alongside the walkway for increased safety.

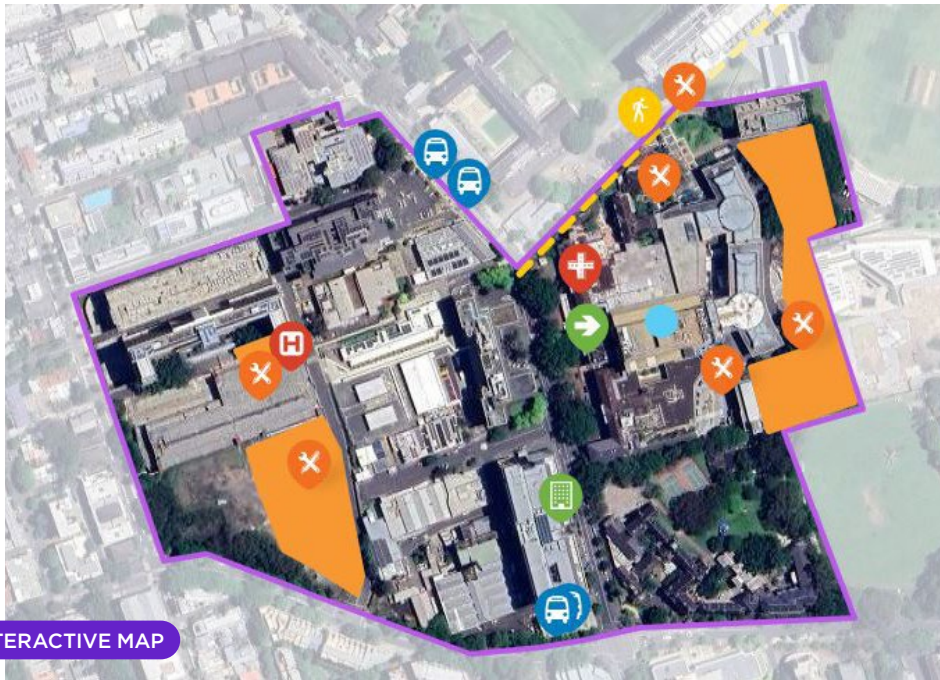
The upcoming construction activities will require some noisy works and we will work with the community to minimise disruptions where possible.

Pedestrian access changes

There have been some changes to access between the Royal Prince Alfred Hospital and Sydney University. The best access for pedestrians is via Johns Hopkins Drive, with no pedestrian access on Lambie Dew Drive.

When moving around the campus be aware of your surroundings, follow the footpath and signs, keep your distance from construction and stay outside safety barriers.

There is a traffic management plan in place for construction works that impact pedestrian and vehicle movement around the campus.
