## Works notice: Monday 15 January 2024 Northern entrance driveway access changes

From 7am on Monday 15 January access to the northern entrance driveway will be adjusted and there will be a permanent loss of three car spaces to enable preparatory works to commence on the future northern arrival.

Access to the northern entrance will be maintained with the entry and exit point moved closer together. The driveway access will be adjusted to ensure vehicles can continue to enter and exit simultanesouly at all times.

These works include the removal of the pedestrian crossing on Johns Hopkins Road and will require a small one-lane road closure. There will be traffic control in place to help pedestrians and vehicles safely navigate the space.



#### **Key impacts**

- Northern entrance driveway entry and exit adjustments
- Three car spaces removed from the northern entrance
- Small one-lane road closure on Johns Hopkins Drive
- Removal of pedestrian crossing on Johns Hopkins Drive
- Access to the loading dock will be maintained for the duration of the works
- Dedicated traffic controllers in place to assist you safely navigate the space
- Increase of construction works and traffic in this area

#### Changes to pedestrian access

Major works to prepare the site for the future 15-storey hospital building have started on Lambie Dew Drive and Johns Hopkins Drive. Changes to pedestrian access between key buildings within the RPA health precinct are required to ensure everyone's safety. Pedestrians are advised that the best access from RPA Hospital through to Sydney University is via the footpath on Johns Hopkins Drive.
