Works notice: Wednesday 14 December

Enabling Works — Gloucester House Drive

Staff and patients may notice works taking place near **Gloucester House Drive**. These are part of enabling works ahead of the main works for the \$750 million redevelopment of RPA Hospital.

Stage 1 of the Gloucester House enabling works will take place from **15 December 2022 until 15 February 2023** and will include civil, and paving upgrade works.

From 7am on Thursday 15 December, an exclusion zone will be prepared with temporary fencing and shade cloths erected around the boundary of the works at the Gloucester House Forecourt.


Changes to Gloucester House Drive

To ensure the safety of all RPA Hospital users, the following traffic changes will be in place during the works:

- From Thursday 15 December, traffic will be directed one way from Missenden Road down Gloucester House Drive, around Lambie Dew Drive onto Johns Hopkins Drive
- Patient drop off will be unavailable directly in front of Gloucester House
- Patients can still access the entrance
 of Gloucester House but will need to be dropped
 off at the atrium at the main RPA clinical services
 building and access Gloucester House by crossing
 Gloucester House Drive and making their way
 along the walkway to Gloucester House
- **Traffic signage** will be in place directing traffic and pedestrians to ensure safety

Stage 2 of the works are due to begin mid-February. Further information on Stage 2 will be provided closer to the time. Dates of works may change subject to weather conditions.
