

Works notice: Expected to start Wednesday 27 March 2024 Piling work on Grose Street near staff and visitor car park

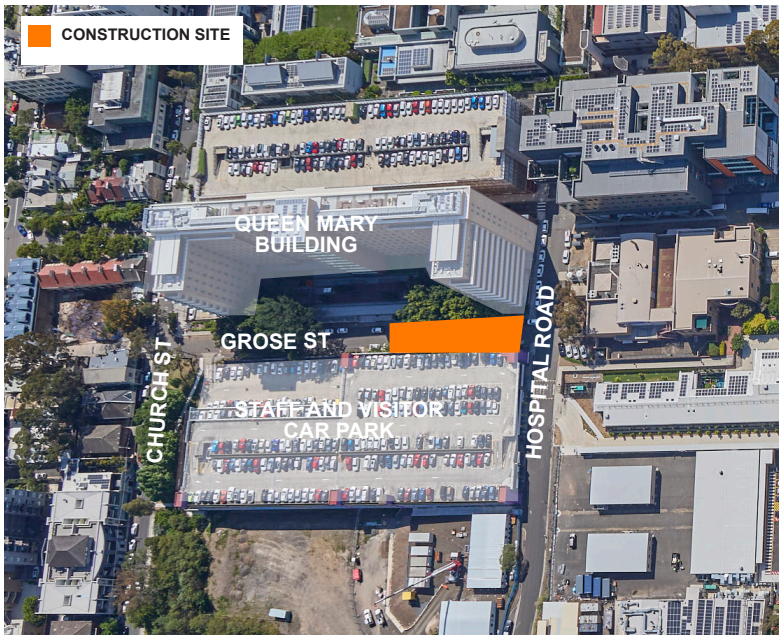
From the Wednesday 27 March 2024 piling works are expected to start in the established construction site on Grose Street.

Piling is the process of installing piles into the ground which can be noisy due to the construction equipment required to complete the works. All noisy works will be completed in intervals of work and respite, and we will continue to monitor and minimise impacts where possible.

The work will require large deliveries of construction material to Grose Street. People are advised to follow all signage in the area to ensure you're taking the safest and most accessible route.

Following these works, our contractors will commence excavation and concrete pouring in this area. We will continue to keep the community updated on the expected impacts as construction progresses.

These works are part of the construction of the temporary helicopter landing site, which is expected to be complete by early 2025. Once completed, the temporary helicopter landing site will be in use for a period of approximately 24 months.
