

Construction Activities February 2024

The NSW Government's \$940 million investment in the redevelopment of Royal Prince Alfred Hospital will be the biggest transformation of RPA in the hospital's 140-year history of caring for the community.

Key construction activities this month include road works on Johns Hopkins Drive and the Womens and Babies driveway, demolition of the former Tissue Pathology and Diagnostic Oncology Department, necessary stormwater drainage works on Lambie Dew Drive and Gloucester House Drive.
