Works notice: Monday 16 December 2024 Johns Hopkins Drive access changes

From Monday 16 December 2024 there will be a full road closure of Johns Hopkins Drive. Access to the RPA Hospital loading dock will be via Gloucester House Drive only.

There will be no through road to Johns Hopkins Drive via Lambie Dew Drive, Gloucester House Drive will increase in traffic and there will be an increase of construction activities occurring on Johns Hopkins Drive.

The pedestrian footpath between RPA Hospital campus and the University of Sydney will remain open and accessible. Cyclists are advised to avoid using Johns Hopkins Drive and Gloucester House Drive to access the University of Sydney campus.

Best access to the University of Sydney and Charles Perkins Centre for cyclists is via Carillon Avenue and via Parramatta Road for vehicles. Always follow direction from traffic controllers and take care when navigating around areas of construction.
