RPA HOSPITAL REDEVELOPMENT




As part of the RPA Redevelopment, on **Saturday 21 January**, works are taking place to remove asbestos identified in the early works compound area on Lambie Dew Drive. An exclusion zone is already in place around the early works compound, adjacent to the RPA

loading dock. During the works additional safety measures will be put in place. The removal works will take place between 7am – 12pm on Saturday 21 January.

As a result of the works:

- For the safety of staff, patients and visitors, an exclusion zone and barricades will be put in place around the removal works area
- Qualified asbestos removal workers will be suited in Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- Environmental site assessments including air monitoring will be carried out during the works
- A truck will travel to the site to remove the material, the truck's load will be covered to ensure the safe transport of contaminated materials
- Once works are complete, an independent assessor will review the site to give clearance certificates
- There will be minimal traffic disruption
