

Works notice: Monday 15 July 2024 RPA loading dock access changes

A range of works have commenced on Lambie Dew Drive for the construction of the 15-storey hospital building as part \$940 million RPA Hospital redevelopment. From Monday 15 July until October 2024, access to the RPA Hospital loading dock will be via Johns Hopkins Drive only.

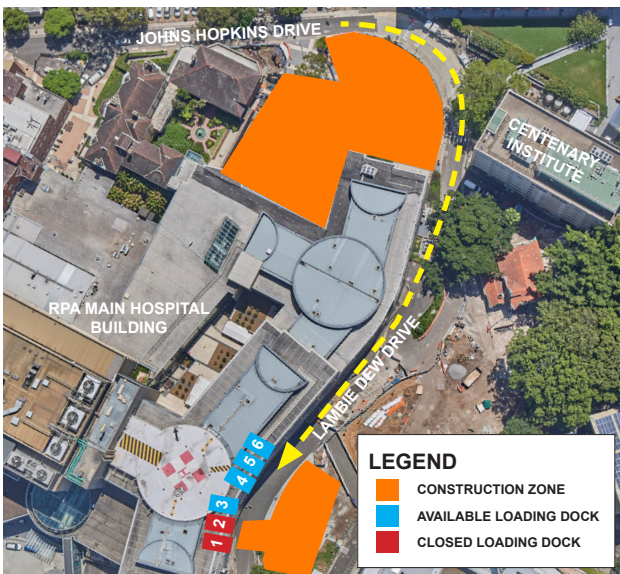
Loading dock bays 1 and 2 will be closed for the duration of works. There will be four available loading docks for suppliers and delivery drivers and signage will be in place on Missenden Road to help people navigate the changes.

Small courier deliveries are advised to use the Logistics Hub located on the Western Campus off Hospital Road.

Logistics Hub address: Hospital Road via Carillon Road, Camperdown (please follow signs and route on the attached/affixed map)

Opening hours: Between 7am and 3.30pm, Monday to Friday (excluding public holidays)

- No through road between Gloucester House Drive and Johns Hopkins Drive
- RPA loading dock turning circle restricted
- Noise, dust and vibration will be monitored and disruptions minimised.
- Dedicated traffic controllers in place to help you navigate the space
