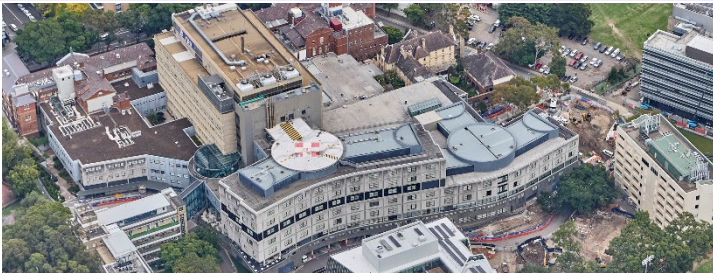


Construction activities update 8 July 2024
