Works notice: Tuesday 7 January 2025 RPA Hospital loading dock bay closures

From Tuesday 7 January 2025, RPA Hospital loading dock bays 3 and 4 will be closed and a construction site will be set up in this space. There is a full road closure on Johns Hopkins Drive and all access to the loading dock remains via Gloucester House Drive only.

Large delivery vehicles are asked to use loading dock bays 5 and 6. These bays can be accessed by following Lambie Dew Drive around the established construction site in bays 3 and 4. Smaller delivery vehicles can use loading dock bays 1 and 2.

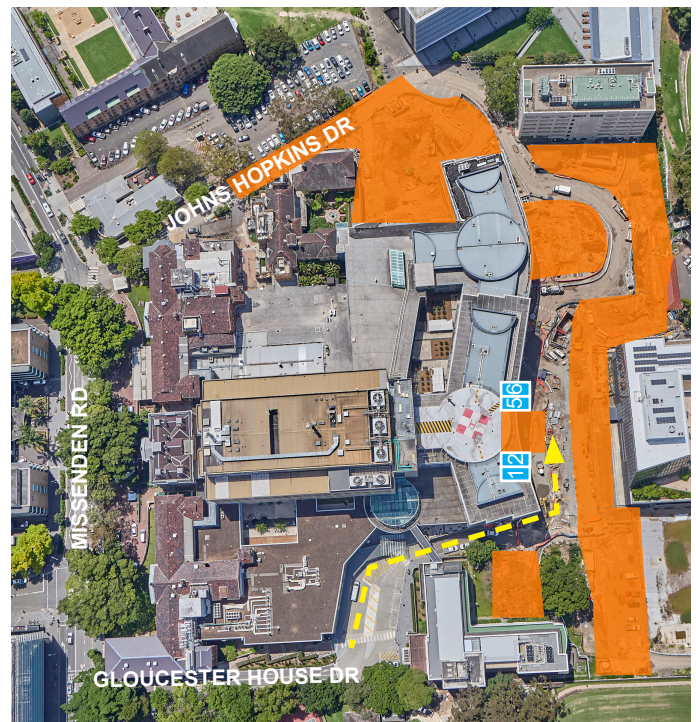
There is no through road to Johns Hopkins Drive via Lambie Dew Drive. The pedestrian footpath between RPA Hospital campus and the University of Sydney remains open and accessible.

Cyclists are advised to avoid using Johns Hopkins Drive and Gloucester House Drive to access the University of Sydney campus.

- Johns Hopkins Drive full road closure and no through road to Lambie Dew Drive
- RPA Hospital loading dock bays 3 and 4 closed
- RPA Hospital loading dock and Centenary Institute vehicle access via Gloucester House Drive only
