

RPA Hospital Redevelopment

Construction update 14 April 2025

Work is progressing on the East campus to prepare the site for the future 15-storey hospital building on Lambie Dew Drive.

Missenden Road

- Work on Missenden Road footpath is expected to recommence in late April 2025.
- The works involve a section of the Missenden Road footpath, outside the Emergency Department drop-off area, which will be closed for approximately six weeks to enable the installation of in-ground infrastructure for the new hospital.
- There will be detours in place to help pedestrians safely navigate around the works.
- The works zone will be demobilised daily, enabling pedestrians to utilise the Missenden Road footpath out of construction hours.

Internal refurbishment works

- Demolition and refurbishment work continues as we reconfigure spaces for the future Eastern expansion.
- There will be upcoming works in the corridor and atrium space on Level 4 of the RPA Hospital main building. Affected stakeholders will be notified of the impacts ahead of works commencing.
- Works are scheduled in late April for the relocation of the reception area for Women & Babies clinic areas on Level 5 of RPA Hospital Main Building, with signs in place to ensure the changeover is smooth for visitors and patients.

Easter holiday period site closure:

The construction site will be closed for the Easter holiday period from Friday 18 April 2025, reopening on Monday 28 April 2025. We thank you for your continued support of the RPA Hospital Redevelopment.
