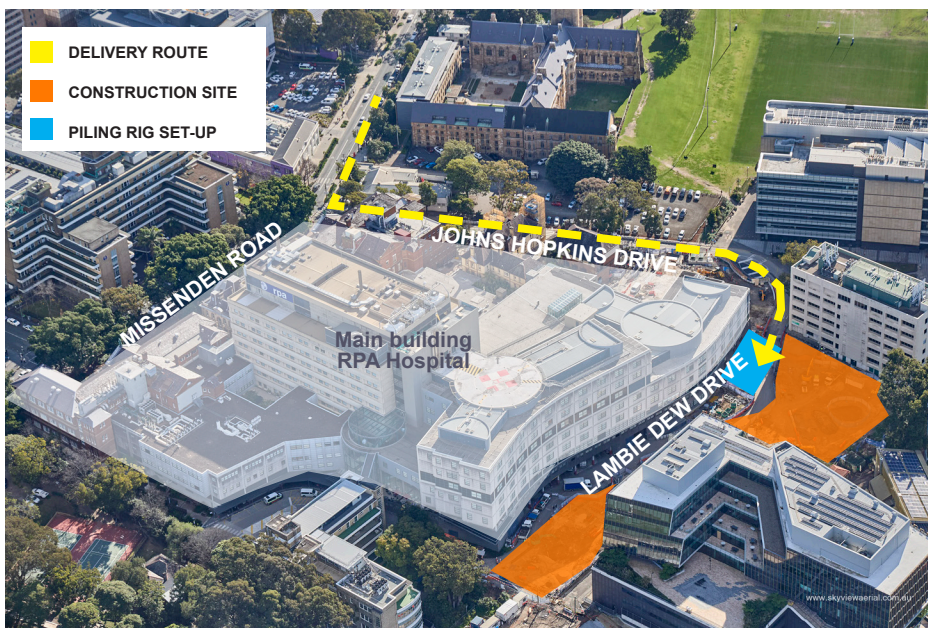


## Works notice: Tuesday 3 September 2024 Piling rig delivery and piling work commencing

Between 3am and 5am on Tuesday 3 September 2024, a piling rig and 20 tonne excavator will be delivered to the construction site on Lambie Dew Drive.

An oversized truck will be delivering the construction machinery via Missenden Road and down Johns Hopkins Drive through to Lambie Dew Drive. There will be traffic controllers on site to help people navigate the space.

The delivery of a piling rig marks the commencement of piling works required for the east tower extension as part of the RPA Hospital redevelopment. Piling is the process of installing steel piles into the ground. The activity is noisy and people nearby may also notice some slight vibration. All noisy works will be completed in intervals, to enable respite periods, and there are noise and vibration monitors installed to monitor impacts. Piling works will occur between 7am to 6pm weekdays.



### Key impacts

- Large delivery of construction machinery down Johns Hopkins Drive to Lambie Dew Drive
- Piling rig installed and in use on Lambie Dew Drive
- Intermittent noise and vibration from piling work on Lambie Dew Drive
