

RPA Hospital Redevelopment Construction update 13 January 2025

The RPA Hospital Redevelopment team are kicking off 2025 with strong momentum, as main works construction continues across the campus. Works continue to ready the east campus for the construction of the 15-storey hospital building which will be located on Lambie Dew Drive, with stair and lift core structures underway and piling continuing. Johns Hopkins Drive has been temporarily closed to enable new in-ground electrical infrastructure to be built, and the RPA Hospital loading dock access is currently via Gloucester House Drive only.

Big news this month as we're gearing up to install the first of two tower cranes on Lambie Dew Drive. This milestone will take place over the course of a weekend and will involve out-of-hours work. Large semi-trailers will be delivering materials and crane equipment down Johns Hopkins Drive to assist with the installation and construction of the tower crane.

Inside the existing hospital building, demolition and refurbishments are in full swing as spaces are reconfigured to suit the future hospital expansion.

The team is off to a fantastic start in 2025, and we can't wait to share more exciting updates as we continue building future of RPA Hospital. Stay tuned for all the milestones and construction activities ahead.
