

## Works notice: Wednesday 3 April 2024 Lambie Dew Drive road closure near Johns Hopkins Drive

From 7am on Wednesday 3 April 2024 for approximately five weeks there will be a complete road closure on Lambie Dew Drive and a small section will be single-lane only.

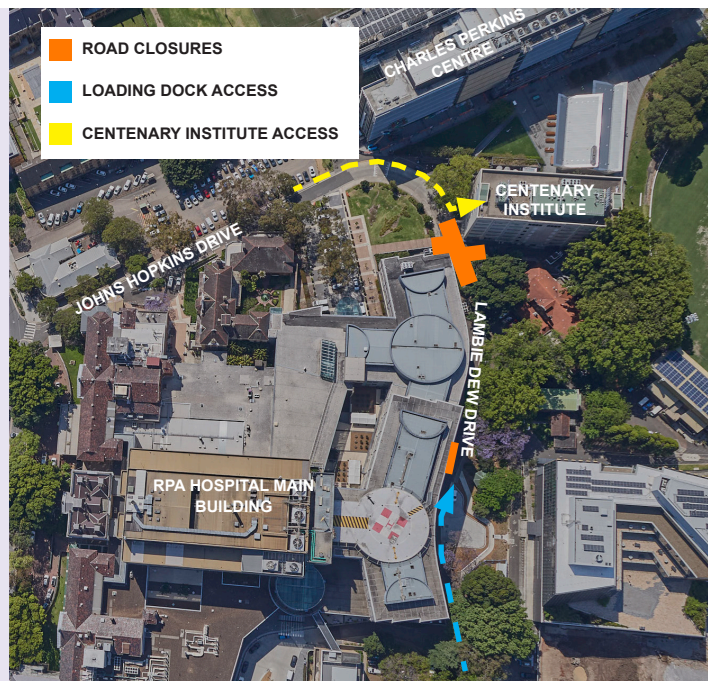
Access to the loading dock will be via Gloucester House Drive only, and access to Centenary Institute will be via Johns Hopkins Drive.

The pedestrian footpath will be maintained along Johns Hopkins Drive and there will be dedicated traffic controllers on site to manage all movements.

These works will require the use of machines and equipment that may cause some noise and vibrations. We will continue to monitor the noise and vibration so we can minimise disruptions where possible.

### Key impacts:

- No through road between Johns Hopkins Drive and Lambie Dew Drive
- Access to loading dock via Gloucester House Drive only
- Access to Centenary Institute via Johns Hopkins Drive only
- Pedestrian footpath maintained on Johns Hopkins Drive
- Increase of construction vehicles on Johns Hopkins Drive
- Possible noise, dust and vibration
- Dedicated traffic controllers on site to assist with navigation
