

As part of the RPA Redevelopment, ongoing works will take place to remove asbestos identified in the turning bay area on Lambie Dew Drive. All will be removed under full 'asbestos removal conditions'. The works will begin this weekend, starting on Saturday, 18 February and be ongoing until completion.

An exclusion zone is already in place around the early works compound, adjacent to the RPA loading dock.

As a precaution, the affected area within the early works compound has been covered in heavy duty plastic sheeting.

During the works additional safety measures will be in place.

As a result of the works:

- For the safety of staff, patients and visitors, an exclusion zone will be in place around the removal works area
- Qualified asbestos removal workers will be suited in Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- Environmental site assessments including air monitoring will be carried out during the works
- Trucks will travel to the site to remove the material, the truck's load will be covered to ensure the safe transport of contaminated materials
- Once works are complete an independent assessor will review the site to give clearance certificates
- There will be minimal traffic disruption.
