

Staff and patients may notice works taking place near Gloucester House Drive. These are part of enabling works ahead of the main works for the \$750 million redevelopment of RPA Hospital.

Set to commence on Saturday 4 March, the Stage 2 Gloucester Drive enabling works will include civil and paving upgrades, as well as enhanced access for delivery vehicles as we lead into main works construction.

To ensure the safety of all, please note the following works taking place:

- The Level 4 Gloucester House link bridge between the main hospital building and Gloucester House will be closed. Access between the main hospital and Gloucester House will be via Level 5 link bridge.
- Gloucester Drive will turn into a two-way street, and the through road to Lambie Dew Drive will be closed. Limited Patient drop-off and pick-up will be available outside Gloucester House entrance

Best access to The Perioperative Unit, ICU and Gloucester House

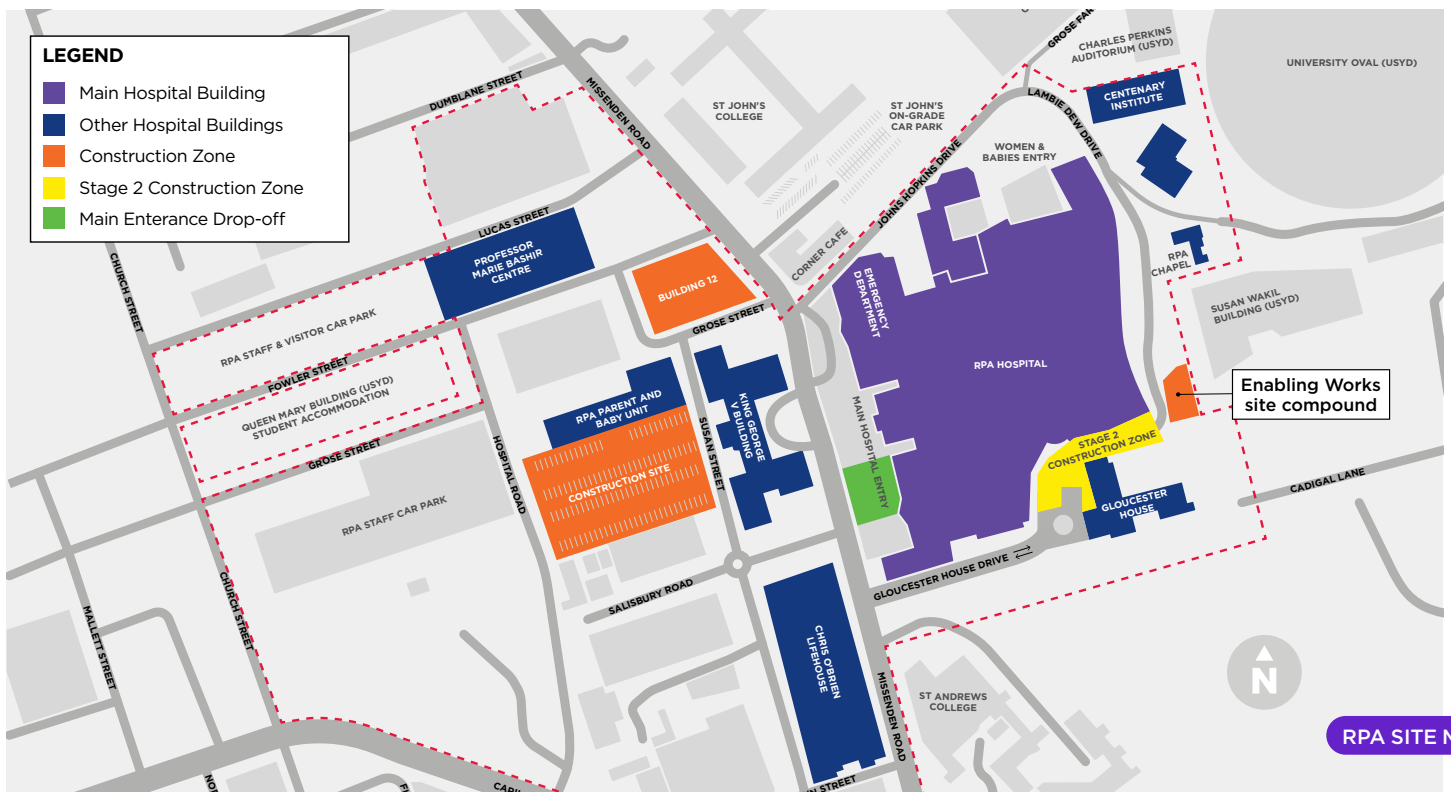
A small drop-off zone will be maintained on Gloucester House Drive. Due to limited bays and expected congestion during peak times, patients and visitors are advised to use the Level 5 Missenden Road drop-off zone and enter via the main hospital foyer when possible.

The Redevelopment Team is working hard to minimise disruptions. There may be periods where noisy works are required. However, the builders will work to keep any disruption to a minimum.
