# Works notice: Tuesday 21 May 2024 Staff and visitor car park changes

From Tuesday 21 May to Friday 7 June 2024 there will be a temporary loss of 19 car spaces on Level 2B of the staff and visitor car park. Works will occur between 7am and 5pm weekdays with possible weekend work occuring between 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.

From Tuesday 21 May to Friday 7 June 2024 there will be an additional temporary loss of car spaces on Level 2B in the staff and visitor car park located on Grose Street. Traffic control will be in place to help people navigate the space, and works will occur outside peak access times.

There will be temporary fencing installed to ensure the safety of all while these excavation and slab pour works occur.

To maximise car spaces, access to the car park will be maintained and our contractors will continue to complete the required works in stages.

We apologise for the inconvenience these works may cause however they are necessary to enable construction on the new helicopter landing site.


