# Information sheet: East campus access changes Johns Hopkins Drive and Gloucester House Drive

From December 2024, there will be a range of access changes on the east campus of RPA Hospital that will impact pedestrian and vehicle movements. People are advised that Gloucester House Drive will increase in traffic and there will be an increase of construction activities occurring on Johns Hopkins Drive.

# Change 1 expected from 16 December 2024

Expected to commence on Monday 16 December 2024, access to RPA Hospital loading dock, Centenary Institute, and the Charles Perkins Centre will be via Gloucester House Drive. There will be no through road to Lambie Dew Drive via Johns Hopkins Drive.

#### Change 2 expected from 7 January 2025

From 7 January 2025, RPA Hospital loading dock bays 3 and 4 will be closed and a construction site will be set up in this space. The Kerry Packer Education Centre will remain accessible via Johns Hopkins Drive.

From 11 January to 12 January 2024 it is expected that the tower cranes required for the construction of the future hospital building on Lambie Dew Drive will be installed. There will be complete road closures during this period and a works notice will be distributed to confirm the date and activities.



### Change 3 expected from March 2025


From March 2025, access to Centenary Institute and the Charles Perkins Centre will be via Johns Hopkins Drive only. There will be no through road to Johns Hopkins Drive via Lambie Dew Drive. Access to RPA Hospital loading dock will remain via Gloucester House Drive.

Small delivery vehicles can use loading dock bays 1 and 2. Larger vehicles are required to use loading dock bays 5 and 6. Loading dock bays 3 and 4 will be closed.

#### Change 4 expected to occur mid-2025

From mid-2025, RPA Hospital loading dock bays 1 to 4 will be opened and bays 5 and 6 will be closed. Access to the mortuary will be via bay 7 on the northern side of the construction site.

Access to Centenary Institute and the Charles Perkins Centre will remain via Johns Hopkins Drive. Access to RPA Hospital loading dock will remain via Lambie Dew Drive.



# Key dates:

16 DEC 2024	Access to RPA Hospital loading dock, Centenary Institute, and the Charles Perkins Centre via Gloucester House Drive only.
11 JAN 2025	Tower crane installed on RPA Hospital campus. Complete road closure and restricted vehicle access. Emergency vehicles will always have right of way.
MAR 2025	Access to RPA Hospital loading dock via Gloucester House Drive. Access to Centenary Institute and Charles Perkins Centre via Johns Hopkins Drive.

#### Pedestrian and vehicle access changes

The pedestrian footpath between RPA Hospital campus and the University of Sydney will remain open and accessible. Bicycle riders are advised to avoid using Johns Hopkins Drive and Gloucester House Drive to access the University of Sydney campus.

Best access to the University of Sydney and Charles Perkins Centre for cyclists is via Carillon Avenue and via Parramatta Road for vehicles. Always follow direction from traffic controllers and take care when navigating around construction.
