

Works notice: Wednesday 10 January 2024

One-lane road closure Lambie Dew Drive

From 7am on Wednesday 10 January to 5pm Friday 12 January 2024 there will be a one-lane road closure on the corner of Johns Hopkins Drive and Lambie Dew Drive. There will also be service works occurring on Gloucester House Drive during these dates.

Access to the loading dock will be maintained for the duration of the works and dedicated traffic controllers will be in place to help pedestrians and vehicles safely navigate the space.



Key impacts

- One-lane road closure on the corner of Johns Hopkins Drive and Lambie Dew Drive
- Service works occurring on Gloucester House Drive
- Access to the loading dock will be maintained for the duration of the works
- Dedicated traffic controllers in place to help people safely navigate the space
- Increase of construction works and traffic in this area
- Changes to pedestrian access on Lambie Dew Drive

Changes to pedestrian access

Major works to prepare the site for the future 15-storey hospital building have started on Lambie Dew Drive and Johns Hopkins Drive. Changes to pedestrian access between key buildings within the RPA health precinct are required to ensure everyone's safety. Pedestrians are advised that the best access from RPA Hospital through to Sydney University is via the footpath on Johns Hopkins Drive.
