Works notice: Friday 12 July 2024 Church Street road closure and detour in place

Stage 2 works on Church Steet are expected to commence on Friday 12 July for approximately three weeks following the completion of Stage 1 works. These works will require a complete road closure of Church Street between Grose Street and Fowler Lane.

Access to the Queen Mary car park off Church Street will be closed for the duration of works. The Queen Mary bin collection will be temporarily located on Grose Street. Access the bin collection point by turning right onto Church Street from Carillon Avenue intersection and then take the first right onto Grose Street.

There will be no street parking available in the closed area. Traffic controllers will be on site to help you navigate the space. Work hours will be from 7am to 5pm weekdays and 7am to 1pm on weekends.

There may be some noise and dust from construction activities during this time. All noisy works will be completed in intervals of work and respite, and there will be noise and dust monitors installed to help minimise impacts where possible.

Key impacts

- Full road closure on Church Street between Grose Street and Fowler Lane
- No access to Queen Mary car park off Church Street
- Queen Mary bin collection temporarily moved to Grose Street
- Loss of parking on small section of Church Street
- Possible intermittent noise and dust
