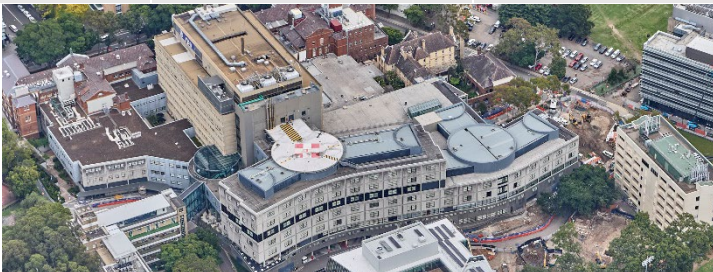


## Construction activities update 22 July 2024
