Information sheet Johns Hopkins Drive road closure

From Tuesday 25 February 2025 for approximately four weeks, the closure of Johns Hopkins Drive will extend to the Missenden Road intersection.

Vehicle impacts

NSW Ambulance access to the Emergency Department drop-off will be maintained however there will be a small adjustment made to the entry driveway.

Vehicle access to Molecular Imaging will be via Gloucester House Drive and the alternative route will be signposted.


Vehicle access to the Centenary Institute, the RPA Hospital mortuary and the loading dock will continue to be via Gloucester House Drive only. Vehicle access to the Kerry Packer Education Centre (KPEC) will not be possible from Johns Hopkins Drive.

Pedestrian impacts

The southern footpath on Johns Hopkins Drive will be closed. Pedestrian access to the Kerry Packer Education Centre (KPEC) and the Albert Pavilion northern staff entrance will remain, and there will be traffic controllers on site to help people navigate around the works.

Key impacts

- · Johns Hopkins Drive full road closure
- NSW Ambulance access maintained with adjustment to entry driveway
- Pedestrian access to KPEC and Albert Pavilion northern staff entrance maintained under traffic control
- Vehicle access to Centenary Institute, RPA Hospital loading dock and mortuary continue to be via Gloucester House Drive only
- Vehicle access to Molecular Imaging via Gloucester House Drive only
- Minor noise, dust and vibration
- Traffic controllers on site
