

Works notice: Wednesday 12 June 2024

Northern arrival canopy removal

From Wednesday 12 June 2024 for approximately two weeks, a mobile crane will be set up in the established construction site outside the future northern entrance on Johns Hopkins Drive.

The mobile crane will be used to disassemble the glass canopy located outside the former Women and Babies entrance. The Kerry Packer Education Centre emergency egress will be maintained and all works will occur within the established site.

These works are part of the construction of the future northern entrance which will have a reimagined cultural garden, places to sit and unwind, and will include a patient drop-off zone.

Road widening works have commenced on Johns Hopkins Drive to enhance pedestrian safety and vehicle movements.

Key impacts

- Mobile crane set up in established site outside future northern entrance
- Glass canopy removal
- KPEC emergency egress maintained
- Increase of construction activity in this area
