Gloucester House Drive vehicle and pedestrian access changes

Enabling Works and Stage 4 Gloucester House Drive

The enabling works on Gloucester House Drive are nearly complete. The final stage requires changes to pedestrian and vehicle access for a three-week period. This will include a temporary full road closure on Gloucester House Drive on **Saturday 15 July 2023**.

From **7am Thursday 22 June**, for the duration of these enabling works, Gloucester House Drive will be singlelane only. The turning bay will be temporarily closed and traffic entering Gloucester House Drive will be required to exit by following the road through to Lambie Dew Drive. There will be no access to Gloucester House Drive via Lambie Dew Drive.

To ensure the safety of all, signage will be in place to direct traffic and pedestrians around these works.

While our builders continue to work on a range of civil and paving upgrades, staff, patients and visitors are advised to please note the following changes:

- Vehicle access to Lambie Dew Drive via Gloucester House Drive is singlelane only
- Vehicle access to Gloucester House Drive via Lambie Dew Drive will be closed
- Patients and visitors are advised to use the Level 5 Missenden Road drop-off zone and enter via the main hospital entrance where possible
- No vehicle access to Gloucester House Drive on Saturday 15 July.

Best access to The Perioperative Unit, ICU and Gloucester House

A small drop-off zone has been maintained on Gloucester House Drive. Due to limited bays and expected congestion during peak times, patients and visitors are advised to use the Level 5 Missenden Road drop-off zone and enter via the main hospital entrance when possible.
