

Works notice: Wednesday 4 December 2024

Grose Street road opening

From Wednesday 4 December to Friday 6 December 2024 the construction site established on Grose Street will be demobilised and access to Grose Street via Hospital Road will re-open.

Works will involve the removal of construction fencing and barriers around the workzone. Once the site has been demobilised, access to Grose Street via Hospital Road will reopen.

Pedestrian access will be maintained and there will be traffic spotters in place to manage pedestrian and vehicle access.

These works are part of the final construction activities for the temporary helicopter landing site (HLS) located on the rooftop of the RPA Hospital Staff and Visitor Car Park.

The temporary HLS is expected to commence operation from December 2024 and will be in use for approximately two years.
